They are an exceptional group of players, who worked hard to ensure that they won their League with a record of 11 and 1. After that great accomplishment, they were bound for America to sample the sport they love in its native environment.

The trip to America was definitely one to remember for all the boys lucky enough to be a part of it. The generosity of all the hosts, the gifts the players received, and the coaching that they received was incredible, and was deeply appreciated by all, players, coaches and families of the boys. Each boy brought home with them their own favourite memories – they will never forget America, and they will probably never be able to repay their hosts for allowing them this experience. This is what makes this project so remarkable – the hosts had nothing to gain – they just gave, gave, gave, and then gave some more. The boys in turn have received goods, received friendship and received that valuable insight into how basketball should really be played, which was probably the most remarkable feature of the trip.

The improvement in play from players has been eye-catching. Three of the team members who went to America as Under 14s, are now, just 6 months later, playing in the Under 19 basketball league. One of the boys, still U14, is without doubt going to be an All-Star this season, and the Under 16 team, having just played it's first game, winning 64-9, are the most feared team in their League. A vast percentage of this team were part of the America trip. The confidence and ability of players like Oisin, Declan, Vic and Daz has soared to unbelievable levels.

There is no doubt that the trip to America has helped these boys. Even the sole session with Coach Connolly seems to have made a real and lasting impact. The boys play with skill and team work and the spirit within the team is on a high. Omagh Thunder is a team to be reckoned with, and this is largely due to the experience the boys had in America.
